Sermon: We live in a society that is so stimulated and it's not bad to be bored or to slow down. We're all trying to do so much, running around. We need to be less stimulated, to have a little quiet, and rest our souls. How do you address boredom? Focus on something you're grateful for. Try to keep up. Make a little bit of time in the morning, slow down, think and prioritize. Make the important things in your life a priority. Address boredom - focus on what you are grateful for. Things that are troubling you - bring it to God. Our souls are restless until they rest in God.

Sermon: During the weekend, I was restless and you know what, I went to the chapel to pray – 20 mins helped me to center myself and address the restlessness. If you need to focus on your parents, children, finance – bring it to god in prayer - find your center and balance. Once you have it - you will find peace. Prepare for the sacrament – show up as a family. We do try to make church fun. During the summer, we had a comedy family night. Last Lent, Pope Francis said we don't have to pray for 24 hours but maybe watch a movie for a little while. Junior ministry – Teen Club is where 7th and 8th graders can socialize and help as a community. Next meeting is next Monday after school – 12:30 pm to 2 pm – 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders. Ask them about – ways to fundraise for their Washington DC trip.
