Calendar – We are on the same schedule as the elementary school. The first day of school is typically the 3rd week of August and the last day is typically the 1st week of June. We close for two weeks at Christmas time and one week at Easter time. Summer Camp begins the Monday after the last day of school and goes for five weeks. We are closed for the next five weeks of Summer.

Priority – Enrollment priority is given as follows: Parishioner, sibling, Catholic and general public.

Acceptance Letters – Acceptance letters are mailed in February. Once you receive your letter you will have one month to turn in the deposit. Our tuition is an annual school fee broken up into 10 payments beginning with the deposit. The second payment is due September 1st and so on until May 1st. Summer camp is optional and a separate fee.

Schedules – Preschool has the choice of 3, 4 or 5 days a week, 8-12:30, 8-3 or 7-6. Pre-k schedules are all 5 days a week, 8-12:30, 8-3 or 7-6.

Uniforms – All students wear a school uniform from Dennis uniform. You can order from their website or visit their warehouse in S.F. We do not allow shoes with laces or open toed shoes at school.

Naptime – We are required to do nap time every day regardless if your child is a “napper” or not. We provide the nap mat and bag and you provide the bedroll. It is called the “Tot Cot” from Urban Infants. It is roughly \$40.

Snack/lunch – We provide a morning snack and an afternoon snack. You provide your child’s lunch. We can warm up any food that needs warming.
