Plan on visiting Khan Academy at least 2-3 times per week during the summer. **Don't wait for the last minute to complete this assignment because the program will shut you out after a certain amount of time.** Hints are available for all the questions--take advantage of the extra help if you need it. An online scratch pad is also available or you can use pencil and paper. Your homepage displays your progress, as well as videos you can watch, and practice activities to complete. You can earn energy points to upgrade your avatar and earn badges. Get a head start so you'll begin 5th grade on point!
- When you have completed ALL the lessons, email me with a screen shot, or a note that you have completed it. The program continuously updates, so if you finish it 2 weeks before school starts, and I login to check your progress on the first day, it will no longer show 100% complete.
