

## SUPPLY LIST FOR SIXTH GRADE: 2016-2017

The following supplies will be needed by sixth graders on the first day of school. Please label all supplies with your name and room number. Also, note that supplies must be replenished as they are used during the year.

1. 4 blue ballpoint pens
2. 4 red ballpoint pens
3. 4 #2 pencils
4. 2 erasers
5. 2 yellow highlighters
6. 1 large durable plastic or cloth bag to hold supplies (no hard boxes due to lack of space)
7. 6 wide-ruled spiral notebooks with 100 or fewer pages for: religion, math, social studies, reading, English, and Spanish
8. Minimum of 100 sheets of wide-ruled binder paper
9. An accordion folder with no more than 7 compartments
10. 200 3x5" white index cards, lined on one side only
11. 2 whiteout tape dispensers
12. Post-it flags, standard or small, arrow flags, or page markers, small, for use with texts
13. Crayons, no more than 12
14. *Crayola Twistables* colored pencils, no more than 12
15. Set of 8 markers, thin style
16. 2 black permanent markers, 1 fine & 1 ultra fine point
17. 2 dry erase markers, any color except yellow, odorless or low odor, any style
18. 1 small sock for dry erase marker storage and as an eraser
19. Scissors
20. Compass
21. Clear protractor
22. 12-inch ruler with metric and standard markings (do not buy a flexible ruler)
23. Liquid glue
24. Small stapler with staples
25. 1 large box of Kleenex and 1 personal pack for desk
26. Handheld calculator
27. The American Heritage Dictionary by Houghton Mifflin Company, Fourth Edition or later (other, similar dictionaries will be fine, too)
28. Paperback thesaurus
29. 3 jumbo and 1 regular size book covers (stretchy cloth) for our hardcover texts. Five soft-cover books will also need to be covered. You may use either paper or reusable covers for these in the fall. (They are approximately 9x12 inches each.)
30. A check payable to St. Anne School in the amount of \$7.50 for the cost of a Bible which needs to be purchased through school to insure uniformity.
31. Each student will need his or her own copy of *Call It Courage* by Armstrong Sperry and *Tuck Everlasting* by Natalie Babbitt. (You do not need a personal copy of *The Adventures of Ulysses* or *The Phantom Tollbooth*). Since we'll be reading these together during the year, your summer is better spent reading other novels to enjoy independently. Please save these to read during the school year.
