

SUPPLY LIST FOR SIXTH GRADE: 2018-2019

The following supplies will be needed by sixth graders on the first day of school. Please label all supplies with your name and room number. Also, note that supplies must be replenished as they are used during the year.

1. 4 blue ballpoint pens
2. 4 red ballpoint pens
3. 4 #2 pencils
4. 2 erasers
5. 2 yellow highlighters
6. 1 or 2 large durable plastic or cloth bags to hold supplies (no hard boxes due to lack of space)
7. 5 wide-ruled spiral notebooks with 100 or fewer pages for: religion, math, social studies, reading, and English
8. Minimum of 100 sheets of wide-ruled binder paper
9. An accordion folder with no more than 7 compartments
10. 200 3x5" white index cards, lined on one side only
11. 2 whiteout tape dispensers
12. Post-it flags, standard or small, arrow flags, or small page markers for use with texts
13. *Crayola Twistables* colored pencils, no more than 12
14. Set of 8 markers, thin style
15. 2 black permanent markers, 1 fine & 1 ultra fine point
16. 2 dry erase markers, any color except yellow, odorless or low odor, any style
17. 1 small sock for dry erase marker storage and as an eraser
18. Scissors
19. Compass
20. Clear protractor
21. 12-inch ruler with metric and standard markings (do not buy a flexible ruler)
22. Liquid glue
23. Small stapler with staples
24. 1 personal pack of tissue for your desk. If your last name begins with A-L, please bring a large box of tissue for the classroom. If your last name begins with M-Z, please bring a large roll of paper towels.
25. Handheld calculator
26. The American Heritage Dictionary by Houghton Mifflin Company, Fourth Edition or later (other, similar dictionaries will be fine, too)
27. Paperback thesaurus
28. 2 jumbo and 1 regular-size book covers (stretchy cloth) for our hardcover texts. Three soft-cover books will also need to be covered with paper in the fall.
29. A check payable to St. Anne School in the amount of \$4.75 for the cost of a Bible which needs to be purchased through school to insure uniformity.
30. Each student will need his or her own copy of Call It Courage by Armstrong Sperry and Tuck Everlasting by Natalie Babbitt. (You do not need a personal copy of The Adventures of Ulysses or The Phantom Tollbooth). Since we'll be reading these four novels together during the year, your summer is better spent reading other novels to enjoy independently. Please save these to read during the school year.
31. For Science: one composition book
32. For Spanish: one double pocket folder (plastic/poly file preferred with fasteners to keep handouts); one package (100 count) 4x6 inch index cards NOT RULED , WHITE; one notebook (spiral or composition book)--it can be the same one that students have from past year if it is still in good condition.
