# VIII. Principal's report (Mr. Thomas White) –

Thank you to Cindy Ng for the hospitality.

 $7^{th}$  and  $8^{th}$  Grade teachers are present. Katie Wilson & Pat Meek, Kathy Kelly and Catherine Vollert. New aids –  $1^{st}$  Grade and  $3^{rd}$  Grade.

USF Volunteers – Volunteer 3 hours / week to cut tuition in half. Volunteers in Kindergarten and 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade. Kids Safe Zone – Taraval police station came up with a program in the community that allows merchants to put up a special purple sign so that they can be a safe area for any children who feel unsafe. We'll be telling the children about this at school.

Star Tests – Concluding this program – finishing up this week. Evaluates child's educational readiness at a particular time of the year. Sept – grades 1-8; Nov – Take it again; May – Take it again. Difference between this and the lowa Test or the SAT is that those tested what you know after a year of learning while Star testing is a formative test (e.g. where are you today and expecting that you learn and grow each time) - it's adaptive - as you answer questions it adjusts the difficulty of the next question and the next test will adapt to where the student ended the prior test. This is a nationally normed test that allows the teachers to see how the students are doing and adjust the teaching.

Ambassador Program – To reach out to our preschool / prek program and introduce them to our community and make them feel welcome in it. Thank you to those who volunteered for the ambassador program.

SAPTO has an opportunity to build the community and make it stronger than it is today. Archbishop Cordileone visited today – started with mass at 8:45AM – children were their usual selves at mass and he commented three times saying thank you for having such wonderfully behaved and involved children. We are 60% non-Catholic, but the respect for the faith and the sacraments the children go through was evident. The children really represent the parents and what the teachers hold them accountable for.

Peer tutoring starts tomorrow.

Seismic work is almost done. Boiler issues seem to be close to resolved. Tomorrow is the final phase of getting the final punch list items checked off.

First school tour is Friday, Sept 28 – two per month, posted on the school website and in the Wednesday newsletter – please tell family and friends who may be interested.

Thank you to the new board, the old board, and to Min.

### IX. Pastor's Report (Fr. Dan Nacimento) –

Thank you to teachers – they didn't have to do anything different or better for the Archbishop's visit. He came away with a great impression of our school.

Jr. High youth ministry will continue. More to follow later in agenda.

Two more programs – 1. 7<sup>th</sup> and 8th Graders last year had Alpha, a program for helping teenagers who want to become Catholic. This is an after-school class for 15 weeks or so. There is also a program Alpha for adults – Wednesdays in October to learn about the Catholic faith. 2. Faith sharing group for adults. Sunday mornings 9-10AM in the school library. "The Crying Group" - Two parents (not from St. Anne) presented the details on the program - Group includes Catholics and non-Catholics, parents of kids of all ages. It's a great support group for faith sharing and struggles as a parent. Starts Oct 14.

i. Back to School Nights were held September 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>. Total used for event was **\$103.61** for water and snacks, left overs being used for SAPTO Hospitality tonight.

### i. 5K Walk (Bonnie Cheng)

- i. The 5K Walk will be taking place on Friday, October 26. Bonnie Cheng, our chair for this event is here and would like to give us some wonderful news about this event.
- ii. Bonnie Kick off on Friday. Hopefully everyone looked at the packet. Event is next month on Friday, Oct 26. Back to our normal schedule food service in the cafeteria (BBQing in the yard). Limited parking in the yard due to parish festival so please carpool, take public transit, or park in the neighborhood. Signup.com is active for this event and half the slots are filled. Donations are online this year for the first time with the hope of generating more revenue. Directions are on page 2 of the packet. Fundraising goal of \$200 per student (not per family). With two children register both children, system will generate an email with a link for each child and will split donations between the children. Donor immediately receives a thank you / tax receipt. Prizes Top 5 children fundraisers 5 hours of volunteer credit. Online system entry of 10 friends / families earns a free dress pass. Early bird if you meet \$200 requirement by Oct 1, you earn a homework pass. If you raise over \$300 10 parish festival game tickets. Top 3 classrooms will get a pizza party on the night of the Christmas program (Dec 18) pizza, fruit, salad, drinks, cookies. Tshirt design contest is ongoing. Please fill out the permission slip by Oct 15. This is my last year, Pui Yee will be taking over next year.
