



Summer Assignment: Bag it!

Materials: A brown paper lunch size bag, colors and other decorating materials ie: stickers white glue or glue stick and..... Imagination!

After reading your Newbery book, you will need to do the following:

Decorate the outside of the bag with stickers, drawings, words, and pictures that help you describe your book. Please remember to include the title, author, and your name on the outside of your bag.

Next step: Please begin to collect items or make drawings to put inside your bag. You will need at least 5 items or more. The items need to represent your book. For example, if you read Cinderella you can put a picture of a pumpkin or a glass slipper. These items need to help explain parts of your story. The items you fill your bag with can be toys, drawings or anything else that can show and explain what your story is about.

The first week of school you will be presenting each item from your bag to the class so you must be able to explain how it connects to the characters, events and theme of your story. It is a great idea to present it first to your family for practice before bringing it to school!
