

Summer Assignments 2025

Students entering Grades 7th and 8th Grades

The Assignments:

- 1) You will choose at least **ONE** book to read this summer. Choose a book that isn't too easy, maybe a little challenging.
- 2) This summer, you will select "**ONE**" book of your choice to read. When you come back to school in August, you will be introduced to a book report called a "One-Pager". This report format is a fun and creative way to share your book with your classmates. Please note that it will require some work as you read your "**ONE**" book.

In order to do well on your first reading/English assignment in August, be sure to do the following **FOR THE BOOK YOU CHOOSE**:

- Read your book completely---no skimming.
- Have the following information written down on or on a Google Doc.
 - author's name and
 - book title
 - a brief summary so you can remember what you read. It should be roughly 6 to 8 sentences.
 - a list of main characters includes 2-3 words/phrases to describe each of them.
 - the protagonist (good character)
 - the antagonist (bad character)?
 - one important quotation (This should be a sentence or two from the book.) Why did you choose this quote? Make sure to also write down the page number.
- Be prepared to answer any questions asked about your books.

*****Important Details to Remember:

Your book selection should be appropriate for your grade/STAR level. Keep in mind, you want to challenge yourself this summer--aim high. Your book choice may be fiction or nonfiction.

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3) Summer is a time for math, too! This summer, I am asking you to complete **10 (ten) hours** of Khan Academy. You should have already signed up at **khanacademy.org** via your school google account. If you are NEW to St. Anne, then you will need assistance from your parents, since you are under 13 years of age. **Next**, visit **khanacademy.org/teachers** and select the “Teachers” tab in your profile. In the “Add-a-teacher” field, enter the **class code (see your class code below)**.

- 5th going into 6th grade class code: **8EWZ6VF9**
- 6th going into 7th grade class code: **ZEP2XRXY**
- 7th going into 8th grade class code: **D3ZTW2E8**

Also, please spend time practicing your multiplication tables and basic math facts for whole numbers as well as fractions and decimals (adding, subtracting, multiplication, and division).
