Before you fret, please know that I have planned carefully to ensure that you and your child will still have ample time to relax and enjoy the summer break. To ensure that they are well prepared to enter the rigors of 5th Grade, these two assignments are geared towards 5th Grade readiness skills. First, your child will read the novel Sian of the Beaver, a short adventure story about independence, responsibility, and survival, all of which your 5th Grader will experience next year. It will lead your child right into our Social Studies curriculum, as well as prepare him/her for Reading/ELA. Students will also be assigned to complete a minimum of 10 hours of Khan "Get Ready for 5th Grade" level Math. As the title states, this will help prepare your child for 5th Grade level math, as well as, review 4th Grade level skills that may need repetition. Please note: It will be imperative that your child master their basic math facts: addition & subtraction (0-30) AND multiplication & division (0-12) prior to the first day of 5th Grade. I guarantee it will be detrimental to your child's progress if they are not mastered skills. Lastly, I would hate to see you and/or your child burned out before the new school year even begins, so make sure that you and your 5th Grader take the time to rest and enjoy the summer break. 5th Grade Summer Assignments

Read the book, Sign of the Beaver, by Elizabeth George Speare.
Complete the <u>Sign of the Beaver</u> Review Packet. (We will correct this packet together as a class starting on the first day of school and there will be a quiz within the first two weeks of school. This packet will help your child study for the quiz.)
Summer is a time for math too! Basic Addition & Subtraction facts (0-30) <u>AND</u> Multiplication & Division facts (0 - 12) <u>MUST BE MASTERED</u> by the time you enter 5th grade. You should also be able to identify place value, multiply multi-digit numbers, do long division, and estimate/round numbers to the nearest thousands. Fraction skills are encouraged, but not mandatory. (Completing the <i>minimum 10 hours</i> of the Khan Academy "Get Ready for 5th Grade" Math Curriculum program will definitely help with these skills.) This program will also be utilized throughout their 5th Grade year.

*Please Note: If your 4th Grader was present at school on Tues 6/4, s/he has already set up their account and can begin. If your 4th Grader was absent or new to the school, please email me so that I can invite them to a Zoom Meeting to walk them through this process. (Completing a minimum of 10 hours is a summer required assignment.)
